Article III	Jurisdiction of and Membership in the Commission

Members of the Commission members are those educational institutions and systems of institutions offering higher education that are accredited by the Commission. To be a Commission member, an educational institution or system of institutions must be within the Commission's Jurisdiction as defined in Section 2 of this Article. Honorary members are those individuals who are nominated and appointed by the Board to this distinction.
